**Summary**

An approach has been received from the Commander Monaro Police District and the Queanbeyan Muslim Community for the provision of a prayer venue during the Holy Month of Ramadan 2019.

The police are supportive of the provision of a suitable facility also recognising the likelihood of police security patrols.

**Recommendation**

**That Council:**

- 1. Authorise the CEO to provide a suitable venue subject to availability during the Holy Month of Ramadan period May-June 2019.**
  - 2. Waive the hall hire fee on this occasion.**

**Background**

An approach has been received from the Commander Monaro Police District and subsequently from the Muslim Community for the use of a suitable facility during the Holy Month of Ramadan (5 May – 4 June 2019, dates may vary).

For many years the Community have been hiring a local privately owned hall for weekly prayers. In the aftermath of the tragic Christchurch attack, a larger congregation during Ramadan is anticipated rendering the current hall less than adequate.

As a mark of condolence and support, it is recommended the use of a Council facility be offered free of charge and treated as a donation in accordance with Council policy.
