Heritage in our region

The Queanbeyan-Palerang Local Government Area includes the townships of Queanbeyan, Bungendore, Braidwood and Captains Flat. Braidwood is also the only heritage listed town in NSW.

The awards celebrate heritage contributions in our community in three categories (Restoration of a heritage building, New building design or Adaptation, and Outstanding Promotion or Contribution to Heritage).

Each year Council offers Heritage Grants with the support of the NSW Heritage Office.

These grants help residents with works to preserve their heritage buildings. Eligible properties may be:

- listed in one of the applicable local environmental plans
- on the State Heritage Register as it applies to Braidwood
- or within a heritage conservation area in the Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council Local Government Area
