Draft Jerrabomberra Innovation Precinct Planning Agreement

The draft Jerrabomberra Innovation Precinct Planning Agreement addresses dedication of land between parties, agreements to collectively contribute funding for identified works, cost sharing for infrastructure such as electricity works, stormwater and water supply, and how the recent grant funding under the 'Growing Local Economies Fund' will be distributed across the various infrastructure elements identified for the site. The agreement can be viewed online, at the Queanbeyan Office at 256 Crawford Street and at Queanbeyan Library. Open until 1 April.

Proposed Second Deed of Variation to Googong Urban Development Local Planning Agreement

The proposed second deed of variation to the Googong Urban Development LPA and the amended Googong Urban Development LPA are available to view and are open for comment until 1 April.

Harmonised rate structure for QPRC

We have developed a new rate structure to apply across all of QPRC and are seeking the community's feedback, specifically on whether the proposed structure distributes the rates burden fairly across the LGA. You can find the structure and background information at our customer service offices or online.

Amendment to Googong Development Control Plan 2010

Council has prepared an amendment to the *Googong Development Control Plan (GDGP) 2010*. The *GDGP 2010* was authorised in December 2010 and has had a number of changes to incorporate new structure plans for the various neighbourhoods at Googong. The current amendment incorporates Neighbourhood Structure Plans for the next stages comprising Neighbourhoods 3 to 5. In addition a number of other changes were required to be made to the *GDGP 2010*.

In summary the changes to the draft document are as follows:

1. Deletion of certain engineering design standards from Part 5 of the *GDGP 2010* as these are now contained separately within the *QDCP* design specifications.
2. Addition of a requirement to provide connection to Googong reticulated alternate water supply system for small lots, studio dwellings, multi dwellings, dual occupancies and residential flat buildings (Part 7 of the *GDGP 2010*) to ensure consistency with the current requirements for single dwellings.
3. A new updated set of Master Plans to replace the existing Master Plan maps as contained in Appendix 8.
4. A new Appendix has been added to include the Neighbourhood Structure Plans for Neighbourhoods 3 to 5 (Appendix 10).

The plan will be on public display until 14 April 2020 at Council's Queanbeyan office, Library and online.

Road Naming

Notice is hereby given that Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council, in pursuance of Section 162 of the *Roads Act 1993* proposes to use the following names as a road name within the Council area:

Proposed Road Name - Aubrey Close

Description - Proposed name for a new rural subdivision just outside the town of Braidwood.

Origin of Name - Aubrey was born, in 1917, into a pioneering family - Hart Family - that settled in the Krawaree area in the 1820's. The property was passed down to our father, Aubrey, and then onto his son, Mark. Because of the long, family association with this holding of land, we think it would be a proper and appropriate manner to remember our father's contribution to the development of the Braidwood region, by naming this Cul-de-Sac after him.

Proposed Road Name - Sparrow Close

Description - Proposed name for a new subdivision in the town of Bungendore.

Origin of Name - Private John William (Bill) Sparrow is listed in the Bungendore War Memorial Hall on the World War 1 roll of Honour. He was wounded and died in Northern France in September 1916.
