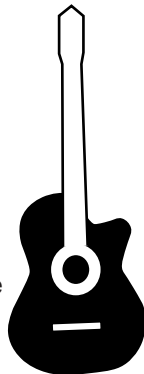


BANG the DORE

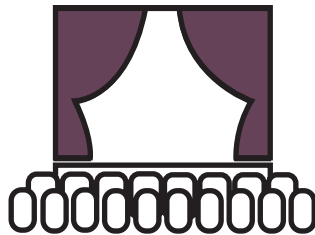

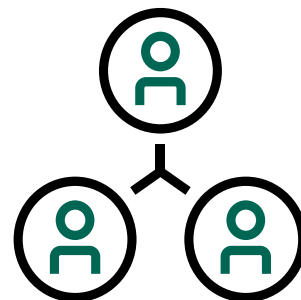
For those wanting to make a presentation on an Agenda item, you can make a:
