

# Braidwood Saleyards

## COVID-19 Guidelines

### Restricted Entry

To ensure that the Braidwood Saleyards can continue to operate for the benefit of the region, attendance at these sales will be restricted to the following:

- Essential saleyards staff;
- Agents and their essential staff/contractors;
- Buyers; and
- Livestock transport operators collecting stock.

Under these Guidelines, there are to be:

- No children under the age of 16;
- No general public; and
- No vendors (vendors are requested to have their agents represent them).

All attendees will be required to complete a declaration upon entry and comply with restrictions detailed in these Guidelines.

If you are included in the list above please do not attend if the following applies to you:

- You have any flu like symptoms (fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose or shortness of breath) that may put other people at risk;
- You have travelled overseas or you have had contact with anyone known to have COVID-19. Do not visit the saleyards for 14 days since last contact or returning from overseas.

### Social Distancing

Agents will have a pre-sale announcement regarding social distancing and will not commence the sale until these requirements are met. There will be representatives from NSW Police onsite to assist with the social distancing requirements. The Police, agents and/or council staff will stop the sale if social distancing is not maintained. If social distancing is repeatedly ignored, individuals may be asked to leave the facility.

People in the sale laneway will be required to keep 1.5m distance between each other at all times.

To further comply with the social distancing regulations, the following must also be adhered to:

- All administration activity will occur from the window of the administration office. Where entry is required, only two people will be allowed at any time – this includes Saleyards staff. You will need to knock on the door and wait until someone leaves the room before entering.
- Please do not congregate outside of the office area.

The truckwash will remain open, however all truck drivers are required to adhere to 1.5m social distancing.

### Hygiene

It is important for everyone to carry out good hygiene practices. Hand sanitiser will be available in the office and the agents room and entry to the sale laneway and soap will be available in the bathrooms.

By all working together we can keep our saleyards operational. Council and the agents are asking for your full co-operation during this time to ensure that we can continue to operate and support the Braidwood region.
