PROJECT UPDATE

Following on from our early advice regarding the Queanbeyan Civic and Cultural Precinct, welcome to our very first project update. Keeping you up to date with the QCCP Project is important to us.

ADCO Constructions will regularly provide project updates to let you know what's happening behind the hoardings and site fencing.

PROJECT START

Early site fencing commences this week, from 2nd August. During this week, minor impacts to the carparking arrangements in the Lowe St carpark will occur. ADCO plans a progressive installation of fencing, and by the 9th August the construction site to be enclosed. At this time, the southern part of Lowe St carpark will no longer be available and we ask that motorists seek alternative parking arrangements.

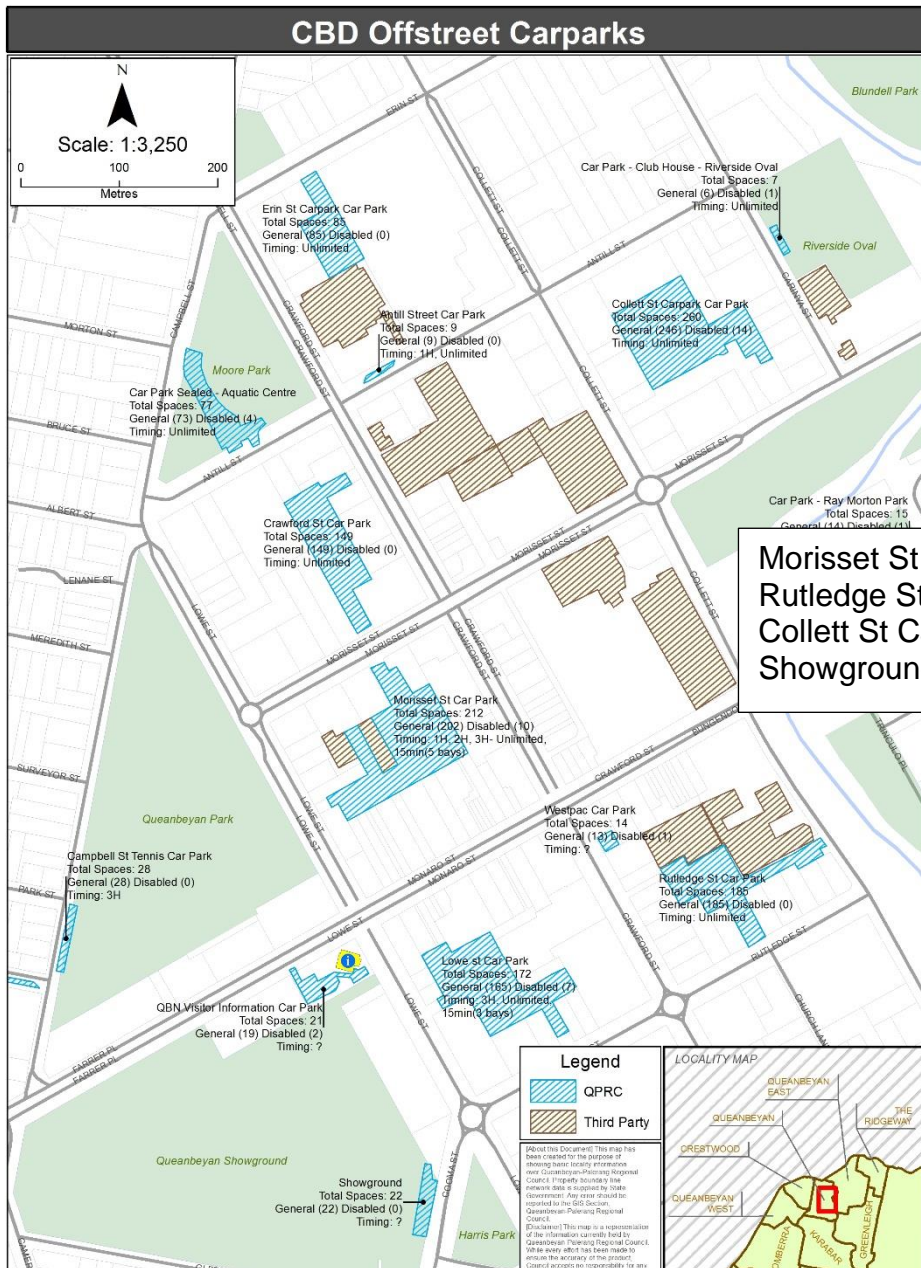

LOOKING FORWARD

Initial works will involve the completion of project hoardings and site fencing and the establishment of site accommodation. These works will occur throughout August.

From mid August, the ADCO team will commence the detailed works required to divert in ground services within the Lowe St carpark. These works pave the way for the commencement of earthworks which are due to commence in November this year.

By early September demolition works will commence along Rutledge St. Details of these works will be contained in future bulletins, however rest assured that the works throughout August includes the implementation of vibration monitoring, along with noise & dust controls.
