## Notice in respect of pesticide use in public place Part 5, Division 2 of the Pesticide Regulation 2017

Location of pesticide use:	Queanbeyan Golf Course, along River Corridor

Full name of pesticide product:	Rabbit Aqueous Pindone Concentrate
Bait material:	Diced carrot treated with Pindone
Pests to be controlled:	Rabbits
Site entry restrictions:	Dogs must be on lead. Notification signs displayed on entrance locations and bait enclosure. Notices will remain in place 4 weeks from last day of baiting.
The pesticide will be applied by:	Queanbeyan Golf Club Representatives, Pindone trained Authorised Users.

## Information about this Notice:

Under the Pesticide Regulation 2017, Councils must give public notice that they intend to use pesticides in outdoor public places and near sensitive places. The NSW EPA regulates compulsory notification.

Under the Pesticide Regulation 2017, at least 5 working days' notice must be provided before a licensed pest management technician (pest controller) uses:

- Pesticides to treat any common areas of a multiple occupancy property
- Spray or liquid pesticides adjacent to a sensitive place (see EPA website for more information).

A copy of a safety data sheet for the pesticide may be requested from the Golf Course or Council.
