1 OUTCOMES:

To clarify the issue of obligation to pay for the raising, lowering or relocation of water meters.

2 POLICY:

That where a water meter is raised, lowered or relocated as a result of works or actions undertaken by the owner/ratepayer wilfully or inadvertently camouflaging or restricting access to the water meter for maintenance, servicing or reading of the meter, the owner/ratepayer is to meet the full cost of raising, lowering or relocation of the meter to a maximum radius of 0.5 meter. If greater distance is required the water service has to be relocated which would attract additional cost by the owner/ratepayer.


