The NSW Government recently rolled out an automated external defibrillator (AED) registration program.

Anyone with access to or management of an AED can register it on their Service NSW account. Registered defibrillators are marked on an interactive map and can be used by anyone in an emergency.

## Parking reminder

Be mindful when parking to keep footpaths clear.

Blocking a footpath creates challenges for those in our community who are aged and frail, vision impaired, in wheelchairs, using mobility scooters, walking with small children or pushing a pram. For some people the option to move to the grass verge or detour on the road is not possible.

There are road rules that discourage drivers from parking on shared paths beside the road. A fine of \$283 applies. The fine increases to \$362 and two demerit points if in a school zone.

Please maintain clear access to footpaths in your area and help to keep our communities safe and accessible.

During the consultation period we received feedback from more than 500 individuals which formed the basis for reports to councillors and the detailed documents which will be sent to the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) dependent on the councillors' decision. IPART granted us an extension to finalise our documents and this extra time will help us to consider all the responses we have received.

Once IPART receive all the necessary documentation from Council in early March the community will have the opportunity to provide further feedback directly to IPART.

#### **FOGO** reminders

Last year we finished delivering Food Organics Garden Organics (FOGO) kitchen caddies to all residents with a three-bin kerbside collection service. Food and garden organics can make up to 50% of landfill bin collections which is why we are now collecting FOGO to make useful products like compost – and reduce the amount of waste that ends up in landfill.

Remember when using your kitchen caddy:

- Kitchen scraps from your caddy should be emptied into your kerbside green bin regularly (this helps to reduce odours)
- Your kerbside green bin is collected fortnightly
- New FOGO bags can be picked up from Council Customer Service Centres

As part of this project we installed a 100,000L bore-fed water tank and solar pump. The tank services the new amenities block and the RFS have access for fire fighting.

Other features include solar lighting, a solar BBQ, and new picnic tables. This upgrade was done with funding from the Federal Government's Black Summer Recovery Grants scheme.

## **New rules** for vehicles

The NSW Government's new Public Spaces Unattended Property laws have replaced the Impounding Act 1993.

This change affects things like cars, stock animals, shopping trolleys and bikes in public places. The new laws are designed to make sure public places are safe and that owners attend to their property within a reasonable time or face regulatory action. Changes for vehicles include:

- A registered vehicle parked safely for more than 28 days may incur a fine.
- Unregistered vehicles may be given notice to remove vehicle after 15 days.
- Unattended vehicles obstructing access or posing safety risk can be removed immediately.
- Shorter disposal times for cars valued under \$1,500.

- Floodlights on fields 1, 3, 5 and 6
- Streetlights on entry roads
- Fencing and drainage around fields 5 and 6
- Irrigation mainlines for all grass fields
