





As you may appreciate any planned work to be undertaken in the area that lies within our tribal boundaries will impact on our cultural heritage. We therefore appreciate that the proper protocol of advising and consulting with us as descendants of the Traditional Custodians has occurred.

The investigation was carried out on the 2nd of August 2012 with your organisation, Cultural Heritage Management Australia (CHMA) P/L. During the survey there were several sites identified in the study area as per the aims of the investigation works.

BNAC have read the draft report from CHMA and support the measures to be implemented according to the recommendations as proposed under the Avoiding and/or Minimising Harm subsection of the Executive Summary.

As an addition to those recommendations BNAC would like to have put in place a cultural awareness process for the site induction which should include the requirement that all vehicular travel should be only within the surveyed easement to minimise the risk of impacting on sites outside the easement that are not included as part of this investigation process. BNAC suggests that the construction company be informed of the OEH penalties that can be imposed for impacting sites knowingly or unknowingly.

BNAC would suggest that if there are to be any changes made that may impact on these recommendations that we be contacted immediately.
