DISCLAIMER

In order to determine compliance with the New South Wales Swimming Pools Act 1992 and subordinate legislation, Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council inspectors are required to undertake a variety of test to ensure that any safety barrier meets appropriate strength and rigidity requirements. The compliance testing may include but is not limited to:

- The application of 330 Newtons (33kg) of force to panel in-fills, top and bottom rails, rods, palings, pickets, and posts;
- Allowing gates (including glass gates) to swing shut under the natural weight of the gate, from its most openable position.

If the fence is not compliant the test may result in damage to your safety barrier. Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council will not be held liable from any damage sustained in the course of testing the strength and rigidity of safety barrier components.

COMMON CAUSES OF STRENGTH AND RIGIDITY TEST FAILURES

Council strongly recommends that owners look for some of the common causes of strength and rigidity failures, as these can often be fixed, strengthened, or reinforced prior to a compliance inspection being undertaken. Some common causes of failure include but are not limited to:

- Fungal rot of wooden components
- Pest damage to components
- UV Radiation causing brittleness in plastic components
- Corrosion or rusting of metal components
- Loose or missing screws/nails
- Damage to concrete footings
- Erosion or looseness of soil around posts and footings
