

5 safety tips for school zones

- 1 Allow enough time to get your child to the school gate safely and without rushing.
- 2 Always observe the parking signs outside the school. They are designed to keep children safe.
- 3 Never park illegally in a driveway on or near a school crossing, or in a bus bay.
- 4 Never double park. Double parking blocks the vision for other drivers, forcing children onto the road and obstructs the flow of traffic.
- 5 Park a few streets away and walk your children to school. This is also good for teaching your children road safety skills.

Always slow down to 40km/h

Set down your child on the school side of the road

Park only where parking is permitted, and

Never call out to your child from across the road

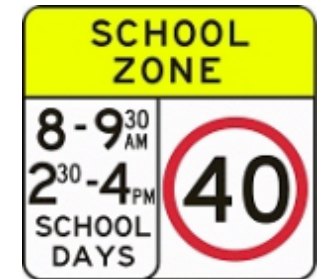
HOLD MY HAND

Children up to 8 years old should hold an adult's hand in the car park, on the footpath and when crossing the road.

Children up to 10 years old should hold an adult's hand when crossing the road.



Drop Off and Pick Up Area in School Zones

DROP OFF AND PICK UP AREA

Kiss and Ride Zones need cooperation to ensure the safety of all children.



Kiss and Ride Rules:

- Kiss and Ride zones and 'No Parking' zones operate under the same conditions
- Maximum stop time is 2 minutes
- Driver must remain in or within 3 metres of vehicle
- Vehicle must not be left unattended
- Zone applies only during hours of operation

Penalty is \$194 and 2 Demerit Points

Safety Tips for drivers using a 'Drop-off and Pick-up' Area

- Always drop-off or pick-up your child from the designated area
- Drivers should remain in their vehicles in the 'Drop-off and Pick-up' Area
- Make sure the hand brake is applied when the vehicle is stationary
- Never double park
- Never park across a pedestrian crossing
- Never undertake a U-turn in close proximity to the school

Safety Tips for student

- Stay buckled up until the vehicle has stopped in the 'Drop-off and Pick-up' Area
- Make sure your school bag and other items are in a safe position, eg on the floor
- Be ready to get out of the car with your belongings when the car has stopped and you have unbuckled your seatbelt
- Always get in and out of the backseat of the vehicle through the safety door—the rear footpath-side door.

Attach this sticker **inside** the rear window closest to the kerb to remind children to use the "Safety Door" when getting in and out of the car.
