



A continuous yellow line along the kerb means NO STOPPING.

This means vehicles may not stop or park next to the yellow line unless there is a medical or other emergency. The lines are used to replace signs to reduce clutter on the streets. The yellow line is enforceable, penalty is \$268\*.
