Wastewater System Checklist

There may be an issue with the system if any of the following are occurring.



- □ Sinks, drains and toilets inside the house don't drain away freely.
- □ There is excessive noise coming from the system.
- There is a sewage odour coming from the system or disposal area.
- There is pooling of liquid around the system or disposal area.
- □ The system is not protected from stormwater run-off.
- □ There is excessive or a large amount of vegetation around the system and/or disposal area.
- For AWTS systems, they have not been serviced regularly (quarterly) or maintained.

If using subsurface disposal

- □ Cattle/horses are allowed in the disposal area.
- □ There is visible damage to the trenches.

If using surface irrigation

- □ Irrigation sprinklers aren't working.
- □ There are missing sprinklers.
- Spray is not contained within a specific area with limited drift or allowed to go over property boundaries.
- Inappropriate hoses and plumbing fittings being used (Fittings should be non-domestic, low pressure, low volume).
