## 'Questions on Notice' from the Public

Responses to the following 'Questions on Notice' received up to Wednesday 4 August 2021 were provided and tabled at the meeting.

## Question submitted by: Paul Hubbard

1. Can I please get a breakdown of the costs incurred in providing the required reports for the Proposed Memorial Site on Old Cooma Road. Cost for:

- Cultural Heritage Study
- Flora and Fauna Study
- Geotechnical Study
- Hydrological Study/ies
- Traffic and Transport Impact Assessment
- Visual and Noise Assessment
- Social Impact Assessment/s

Response: Natural and Built Character
Specific tender details remain commercial-in-confidence, however Council can disclose that the total expenditure for consultants on the strategic planning for the Memorial Park project to date has been $\$ 195,753$.

## Questions submitted by: Katrina Willis

Proposed Queanbeyan Botanical Gardens
2. Has the cost of the proposed Botanical Gardens for Queanbeyan been determined? If so, what is the estimated cost? How does the council plan to fund the works?

## Response: Natural and Built Character

The project has not yet progressed to a stage where final costs estimates can be confirmed. At its 28 July 2021 meeting, Council resolved to further develop the designs, taking community feedback into account. These further designs will allow more accurate costs to be determined for the new Council to consider as part of the next draft Delivery Program. The proposed gardens is a long term legacy project that can be delivered in multiple stages, over an extended period, as funds become available via grants, or through community contribution under a "Friends" group, and QPRC development of apprentices and trainees for example.

To date, Council has spent $\$ 4,000$ on a consultant, plus some staff hours to coordinate the project.
3. Has the proposal been assessed against the Queanbeyan River Riparian Corridor Plan of Management? If so, what was the outcome of the assessment?

## Response: Natural and Built Character

Yes, staff refer to the Queanbeyan River Riparian Corridor Strategy when preparing project plans for projects in or near the river corridor. The proposed Sister City - Botanic Garden project acts on several recommendations in the Strategy such as riparian restoration, environmental education and Aboriginal cultural awareness. The Strategy also notes "there was strong community interest in the issue of public access along the river corridor" which will be further enhanced through expansion of the river walk.

The Strategy also acknowledges the need for a connection with the Queanbeyan CBD Transformation Strategy. This project forms stage 8 of that strategy.
4. Has the proposed botanical gardens had an environmental impact assessment? If not, will an environmental impact assessment be undertaken and when?

## Response: Natural and Built Character

The project is in the early design phase. Each future stage of the project will have the appropriate environmental assessment, determined by the works involved, eg Development Application, REF, Part 5 Assessment etc, prior to progressing.

## Old Cooma Rd tree planting

5. What tree species have been planted along the median strip constructed along Old Cooma Rd adjacent to the Googong township development?

Response: Natural and Built Character

The trees planted in the central median of Old Cooma Rd, between Wellsvale Drive and Googong Dam Road are Liquidambars and were requested by the developers to tie in with other street tree plantings in the adjoining development.

Electrical vehicle charging infrastructure
6. Did the council approach any service stations, motels, hotels or other accommodation businesses in Greater Queanbeyan seeking interest in installing EV charging units before it finalised proposals for EV charging infrastructure for the local government area? If so, what were the outcomes of those discussions?

## Response: Natural and Built Character

Council has not finalised or accepted any third-party proposals for EV charging infrastructure in the LGA, aside from a non-binding agreement with the NRMA for EV charging at the proposed Braidwood off street carpark. Council does however have various plans and strategies which look to increase EV charging infrastructure both privately and publicly within the region such as the QPRC Climate Change Action Plans and Queanbeyan CBD Carparking Strategy.

In the coming months Council will be preparing a tender for the provision of third-party owned EV charging infrastructure in a number Council owned car parks under a lease agreement model of ownership. Council has no role in provision of infrastructure on private properties.

## Questions submitted by: Sandra Young

7. In a 3 month period, how much money, on the average, does the QPRC receive in rates, (please include yearly rate payments $\div 4$ )?

Response: Organisation Capability
$\$ 10,154,000$ in rates every 3 months. The value expected and actual rates are disclosed in the Operational Plan and annual financial statements.
8. As of August 1, 2021, what are the total unencumbered financial reserves for QPRC (or those not subject to loan repayments etc)?

Response: Organisation Capability
$\$ 15,000,000$ as at 30 June 2021 - this figure is currently in the final stages of reconciliation, taking into account the external income sources that Council receives. The reserves balances are disclosed in the annual financial statements.
9. In the last financial year, how many loans has the QPRC received from the NSW government and what was the total value of these loans?

## Response: Organisation Capability

Nil from the State Government, but \$10,180,000 from TCorp - a central borrowing authority for the NSW public sector. Council's borrowings are disclosed in the Operational Plan. These borrowings were applied as follows:

- $\$ 7,263,000$ for the first tranche of borrowing for the Queanbeyan Civic and Cultural Precinct
- \$2,800,000 for street lighting LED upgrades
- $\$ 117,000$ for the Bicentennial Hall upgrade

10. In a 3 month period, how much interest is paid on all QPRC loans?

Response: Organisation Capability
$\$ 806,730$ interest is payable in a 3 month period during 2021/22 on all existing Council loans, including general, water and sewer fund. As referenced in Q7-9, the borrowings and interest charges are disclosed in the Operational Plan and annual financial statements.
11. How many loans does QPRC currently hold, and what is the main purpose for each of these loans?

## Response: Organisation Capability

15 loans. The loan schedule is provided as an attachment.
12. What is the number of staff on the Council Payroll, internal and external?

## Response: Organisation Capability

Council has 535 ongoing and fixed term staff members. This includes almost 100 casuals.
13. In a 3 month period, what is the total for all QPRC staff salary payments?

## Response: Organisation Capability

Based on current staff numbers and pay rates, Council expects to pay $\$ 9,347,162$ wages over a three-month period

Total employment costs are disclosed in the Operational Plan and annual financial statements.
14. How many staff are paid more than $\$ 200$, 000 per year?

Response: Organisation Capability
There are eight staff with a total remuneration package greater than $\$ 200,000$.
15. What are the $\mathbf{3}$ month super payments that the QPRC are liable for?

Response: Organisation Capability
Based on current staff numbers and pay rates, Council can expect to pay $\$ 902,297$ in super payments over a three-month period.
16. Over the next 10 years, what are the expected super and staff payments expected to be every 3 months?

Response: Organisation Capability
Detailed figures are unable to be provided due to the likelihood of change over the next 10 years, noting annual Award increases and super guarantee increases are expected over that period.

Projections in Council's Long Term Financial Plan include an annual 2.5\% increase in employee benefits. Employee costs are estimated at $\$ 35.8 \mathrm{~m}$ as disclosed in the 2021-22 Operational Plan, representing $27 \%$ of the Budget. Council is currently reviewing its Long Term Financial Plan.
17. What are the total expenses, so far, or in the near future, for a.) the demolition and removal of the old Queanbeyan council building, b.) the total architectural fees so far paid, or estimated costs, payable on completion of the two new proposed Queanbeyan Council buildings?

## Response: Organisation Capability

The cost of demolition and removal of the former building at 257 Crawford Street, Queanbeyan was $\$ 474,000$ excluding GST.

The architectural costs for the new Queanbeyan Civic and Cultural Precinct are as follows:

- Concept design - \$200,000 excluding GST
- Detail design (including interior design and construction phase services) - \$1,682,000 excluding GST

These costs are the architectural fees only and exclude other building consultants' fees which amount to $\$ 2.6 \mathrm{M}$ excluding GST.
18. What is the cost of consultants to QPRC over the past 12 months and what is the purpose of each consultancy?

## Response: Organisation Capability

The following consultancy costs will be reported in Council's end of year financial statements, noting that the cost of consultants used in capital works projects is included in the total cost of the capital project for reporting, and therefore are not shown in the below list.
