'Questions on Notice' from the Public

Responses to the following 'Questions on Notice' received up to *Wednesday 16 November 2022* were provided and tabled at the meeting.

Questions submitted by: Save Bungendore Park Inc

We refer to the Member for Monaro's press release of 20 October 2022 (available at https://www.nicholeoverall.com.au/media-releases/more-car-parking-for-bungendore-education-precinct/). Could you please advise:

1. Has Council been party to any discussions with the Member for Monaro and/or School Infrastructure NSW in relation to the parking referred to in the press release?

Council staff were briefed by School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW)/Department of Education (DoE) on Wednesday 16 November 2022, where they presented a revised parking plan for the proposed high school. The parking is within the school grounds and along Turallo Terrace.

Council was also presented with draft responses to the other traffic issues raised by Council in their objection submitted to the amended plans and first Response to Submissions Report.

2. If so, when did those discussions occur and what was the nature and outcome of those discussions?

This meeting was held online on Wednesday 16 November 2022, there was no outcome of the meeting.

- 3. Is Council aware of any details of the proposed parking referred to in the media release? If so:
 - (a) Where is it proposed to be located and how will it be accessed?
 - (b) How many spaces are proposed?
 - (c) When will it be constructed?
 - (d) What consultation has been undertaken with surrounding landowners or occupants?
 - (e) How will the site and the parking be procured?
 - (f) What planning or other approvals will be required?
 - (g) Does Council support this proposal?
 - (h) What consultation does Council propose to undertake in relation to this proposal?
 - (i) Has any traffic or other safety assessment been undertaken?

The Department of Education (DoE) are the owners of this project and Council is not the determining authority.

It is recommended these questions are referred to the DoE. Council understands that DoE will be finalising the amended design including the final parking arrangements in response to the feedback and submissions made, which will be included in the next Response to Submissions Report.

The DoE are aware of Council's objections regarding the parking for the proposed high school.

- 4. Are there any matters relevant to the questions above which Council considers it is unable to disclose at present? If so:
 - (a) Why is Council unable to disclose those matters?
 - (b) If Council is doing so at the request of a third party, who is that third party and what legal basis does it have for making that request?
 - (c) When will that information be released?"

Whilst Council have viewed these plans, they are not a Council document. Council has not been asked to not disclose the plans. However, on the basis they may change, the General Manager has decided that Council is not in a position to share them.

We understand that the plans will be published on the Department of Planning SSDA website when the Response to Submissions Report is submitted. Council will ensure the community are aware of this when it is available.
