'Questions on Notice' from the Public

Responses to the following 'Questions on Notice' received up to *Wednesday 6 April 2022* were provided and tabled at the meeting.

Questions submitted by: Margot Sachse - Jerrabomberra Residents Association

In 2019 SLR Consulting Australia Pty Ltd (SLR) was commissioned by QPRC to undertake a post-construction noise assessment of the road noise impacts from Edwin Land Parkway in Jerrabomberra. A Noise Study was undertaken on the level of noise generated from the Edwin Land Parkway and noise monitoring occurred in about May 2019. Road traffic noise was considered in relation to criteria within the Roads and Maritime Service Road Noise Policy. The results of this study were presented to the Council at the 26 February 2020 meeting. The following questions relate to the Noise Study.

1. Why won't Council release the 2019 SLR report that was the background to the 26 February 2020 Agenda 9.6 Edwin Land Parkway Road Noise Study item to the community?

Response: Community Connection

In August 2021, Council recorded noise from Edwin Land Parkway to determine if any changes to traffic noise had occurred since the 2019 recordings were taken. During this phase (complete suitable treatments as referred to in Q2) it was found that the original noise model (SLR) had omitted the existing back fences of some of the properties. This omission would result in the predicted noise levels at the relevant houses being greater than actual noise levels.

The omissions identified in the 2019 report (SLR) will be corrected in the current report (WSP) and both reports will be released concurrently to provide further clarity.

2. When will the community get the 2019 SLR report AND the results of the \$30k allocated to complete the assessment and design of suitable treatments to reduce road noise to compliant levels?

Response: Community Connection

Both of the reports referred to in Q1, and a memo clarifying the above-mentioned omissions, are expected to be reported to Council at the end of May 2022.
