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Braidwood Overland Flow Study	Braidwood Floodplain Risk Management Study & Plan (FRMS&P) identified that existing development in Braidwood (including numerous main street retail outlets) is impacted by Major Overland Flow during intense short-duration storm events. This was not included in the scope of the Floodplain Risk Management Study (FRMS) which concentrated on mainstream flooding from creeks. The FRMP recommended that Council investigate and define the nature of and options to manage Major Overland Flow in the urbanised parts of Braidwood.
