#### **End of Financial Year position**

Council's consolidated operating result (after capital) is a surplus of \$9.3m.

Council's operating result by fund is:

- General Fund \$3.9m deficit
- Water Fund \$5.4m surplus
- Sewer Fund \$7.8m surplus

This result is an improvement on last year's consolidated deficit of \$48K

# Braidwood Water Supply - Water Security Assessment and Drought Contingency Plan

After the drought we took the opportunity to review our actions and the underlying water security for Braidwood by engaging NSW Public Works Advisory to conduct a study.

The study identified a revised water security quantum, made recommendations for future restriction triggers and highlighted an issue with persistent baseline water demand.




