Council's consolidated operating result (after capital) is a surplus of \$9.3m.

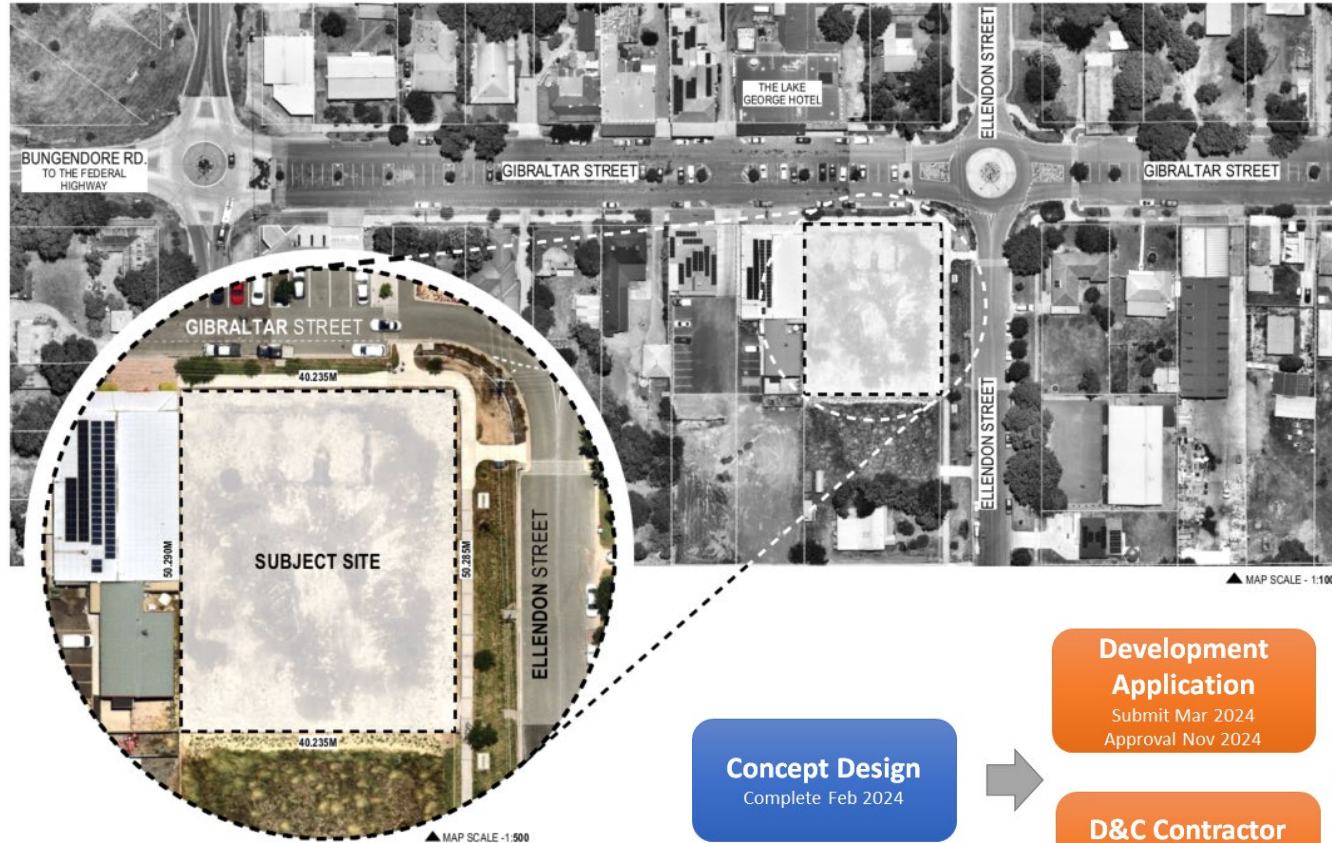
Council's operating result by fund is:

- General Fund - \$3.9m deficit
- Water Fund - \$5.4m surplus
- Sewer Fund - \$7.8m surplus

This result is an improvement on last year's consolidated deficit of \$48K.

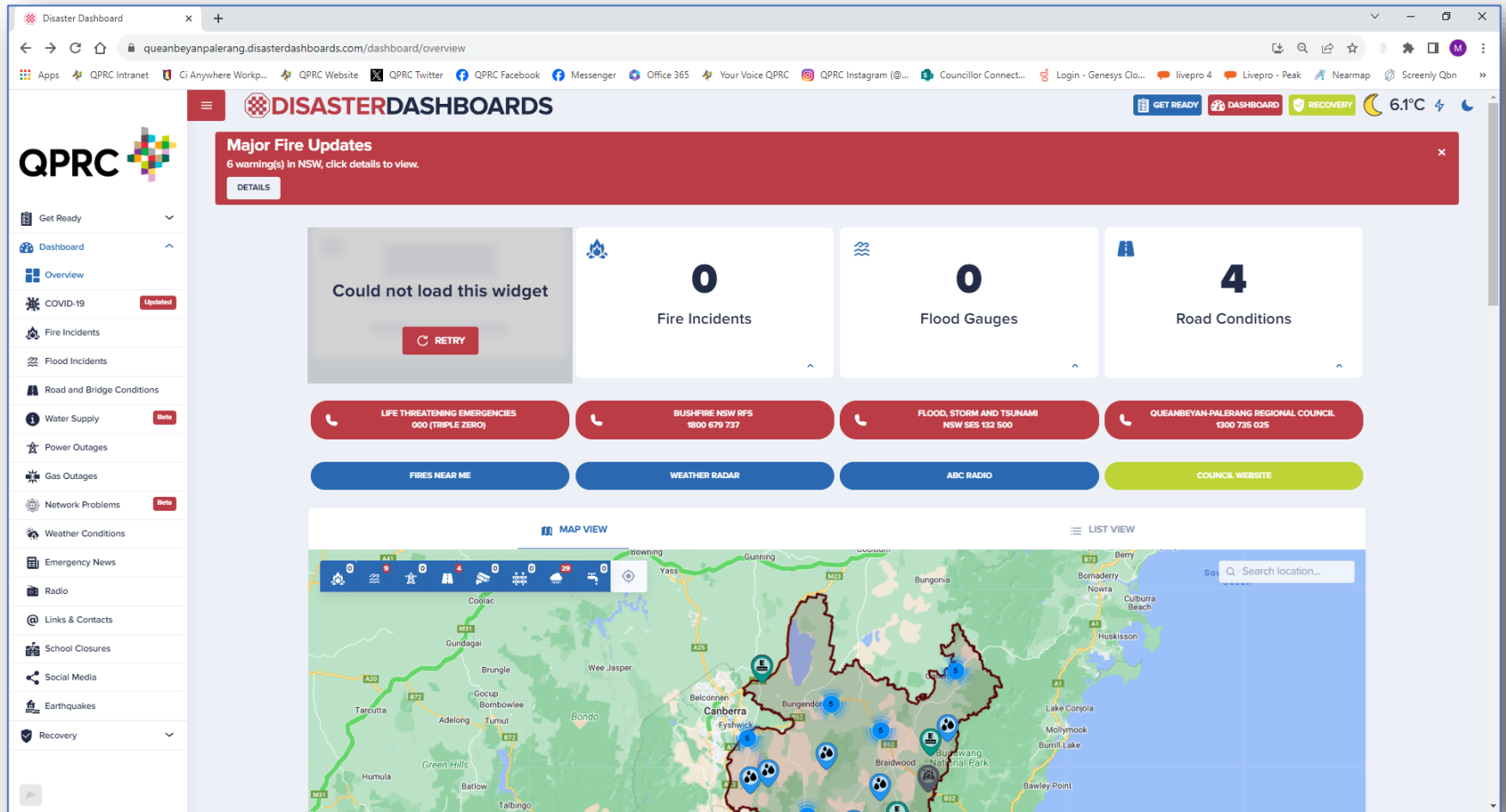

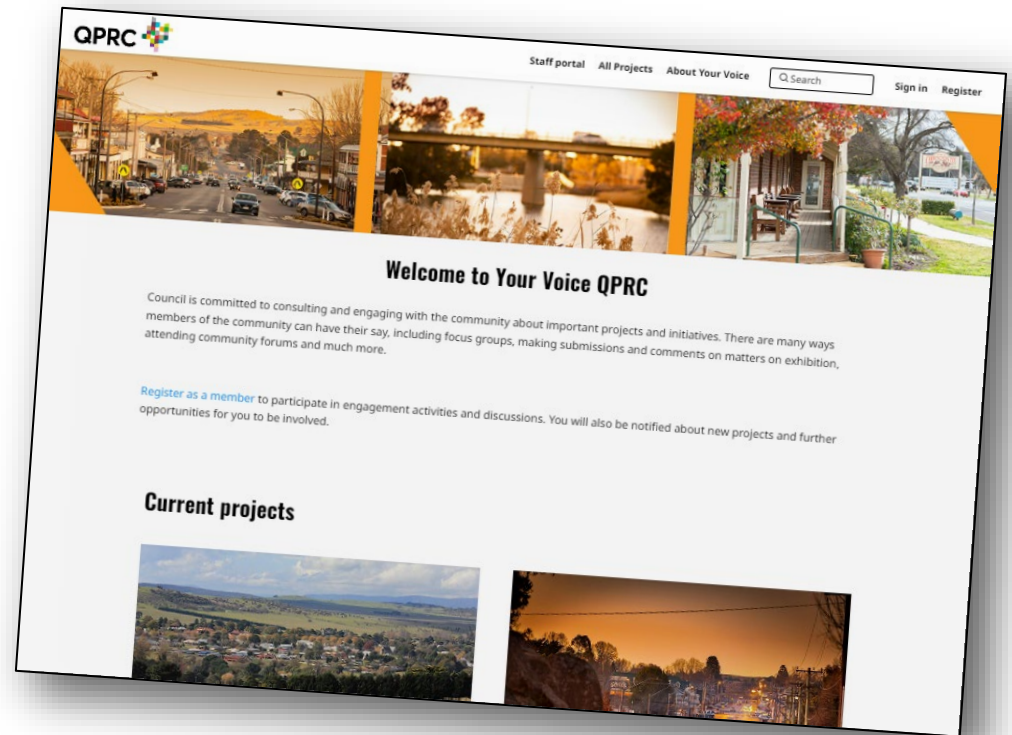
