# **Questions submitted by: Cameron Stack**

1. How might council consider bringing forward plans to implement a shared pathway to the childcare centre on Forster st (west) in annual budget and prior to finalisation of the Bungendore integrated transport strategy for reasons of public and pedestrian safety.

#### **Response – Community Connections**

A shared path along Forster Street (between Molongolo St and Ellendon St) is listed as a high priority project in the Bungendore Pedestrian and Mobility Plan which was adopted as part of the Integrated Transport Strategy in 2019. It is listed in ninth spot in the list of high priority shared paths to construct in Bungendore behind higher priority paths in the area.
