Araluen Road was damaged by multiple landslips from flood events between 2020 and 2022.

Works Update Araluen Landslips

Work on the first three sites was completed in early 2023 and the successful tenderer for the remaining sites has been chosen.

Initial meetings have been held with our contractor, Specialised Geo Pty Ltd. We expect them to be on site from 27 April to begin repairs on the remaining eleven sites.

The contractor will begin on the sealed section of the road that currently has traffic lights before moving along to the others.

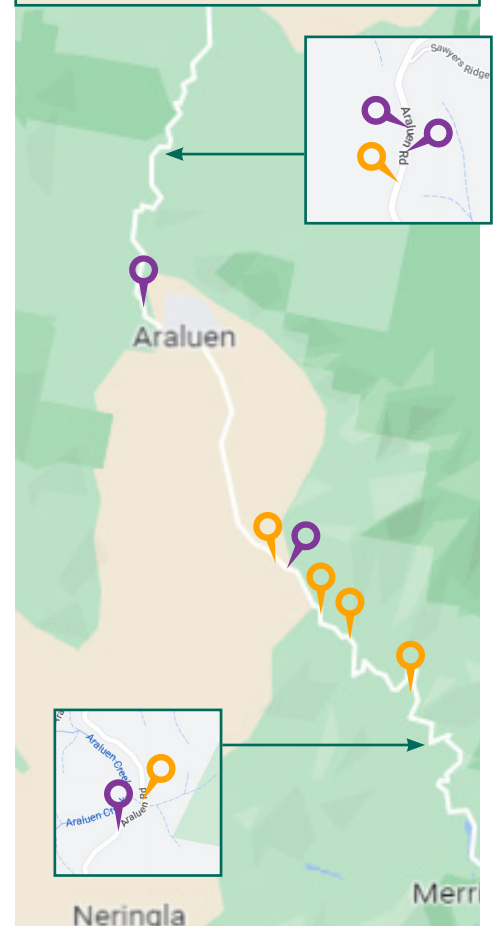
Changes to traffic flow will occur throughout the works. We encourage road users to drive to conditions, observe roadwork signage, obey the directions of traffic controllers and drive safely.
