# BUNGENDORE FLOOD RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN

## IMPLEMENTATION MEASURE ONE - JULY 2020

### What is being done?

Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council has engaged a contractor to carry out the Bungendore Flood Risk Management Plan Implementation Measure One works. This involves vegetation clearing and reshaping where Turallo and Halfway Creeks meet to reduce flooding impacts in Bungendore.

### Why do we need to do this work?

Flooding of Turallo and Halfway Creeks results in economic and social impacts to residents and business owners in Bungendore.

In 2014 Council adopted a Floodplain Risk Management Plan for Bungendore which recommended a variety of flood mitigation measures be implemented. This led to the design of three physical flood mitigation measures aimed at reducing the impacts of flooding in Bungendore. Grant funding has been obtained for the Measure One works, with other physical flood mitigation measures to be implemented in future years.

The Measure One flood mitigation works will enhance the capacity for floodwaters to escape more rapidly from where Turallo and Halfway Creeks meet during major flood events.

### Who is involved in this project?

Council is coordinating this project and has engaged Guideline ACT to carry out the works. The project is funded by the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) under the 2019/20 Natural Disaster Resilience Program's Floodplain Grants Scheme. Under the funding agreement, Council will provide one third of the total project funding.

Measure Two involves upgrading the existing Turallo Terrace levee. Measure Three involves construction of an overflow channel across Tarago Road.

### How is the work being scheduled?

Work is scheduled to commence on 20 July and is expected to be complete by the end of 2020. The works will involve the following:

- Vegetation clearing (weeds and non-native species)
- Excavation works to reshape the creek embankments
- Revegetation which will involve planting native trees and shrubs





## Impact to residents

There may be some increased noise from the work site which could impact residents adjacent Frogs Hollow Reserve on Molonglo Street.

Works are planned to be carried out from 7am – 5pm Monday to Friday.

There will be no impact to property accesses during construction.

## Impact to traffic

No significant traffic delays are expected during construction. Some temporary traffic control signage may be placed on Molonglo Street and Bungendore Road near the work site.

Please observe the roadwork signage and obey the directions of traffic controllers.
