## COMPLETION OF NEW ACCESS TO THE Q AND BICENTENNIAL HALL

- Completion of the new main entry into The Q, now offering direct access into the building for staff members of the public.
- Completion of 5 disabled car parking spaces which now offers members of the public clear and safe access into The Q
- Completion of new fire exit between the Bicentennial Hall and The Q

## DEMOLITION AND CIVIL WORKS

Works are well underway with demolition of the former Queanbeyan Radio building and smaller structures at 10 Rutledge now complete. Internal demolition is currently underway inside 10 Rutledge with demolition planned in the coming week.



Within the next 2 weeks you will see a piling rig being established on site so the team can commence with inground piles. To further assist stakeholders and surrounding buildings with noise mitigation, the team have introduced a passive piling technique to help minimize the noise and disturbances within this process.

During these demolition and civil processes, ADCO are continuously actively monitoring any movement that may be experience with these construction works.
