
Platypus & Rakali Monitoring Program 2021 Mid-Year Report

This year has seen a small decrease in sightings, but an increase in range across the QPRC region.





• The number of participants has risen from 57 to 74 (77% increase)

There was a noticeable spike in rakali sightings after the March flood events in the area.

Platypus activity will increase from late winter as the breeding season begins.
