#### **ROAD RULE #203**

## DO NOT STOP IN A PARKING AREA FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

A driver must not stop in a parking area for people with disabilities. A parking area for people with disabilities is indicated by a road marking and/or a sign displaying a people with disabilities symbol.



#### **ROAD RULE #208 (6)**

### DO NOT PARK WITHIN 3M OF A CONTINUOUS DIVIDING LINE

If the road has a continuous dividing line or a dividing strip, the driver must position the vehicle at least 3 meters from the continuous dividing line or dividing strip.

If you have received a parking penalty notice, youneed to finalise the matter within twenty-one days to ensure that further action isn't taken against you by Revenue NSW.
